# **SPECTATORS**





#### ...towards COACHES

**RESPECT** the coach and the decisions made by supporting the players through the tasks they have been given

Do not **DISRESPECT** the coach and negatively impact the **LEARNING** of players through confusing and contradictory instruction

#### ...towards CLUBS

Remember that the players, coaches and referee may be **LEARNING** the game

Encourage your child and/or players to **RESPECT** the opposition and match officials

**RESPECT** the opposition, and the badge and values of your own club

Do not affect the **SAFETY** of others by entering the field of play without reasonable permission

#### ...towards PLAYERS

Remember that most players **ENGAGE** in football because it's fun

**RESPECT** and appreciate good play, whichever team it comes from

Do not **DISRESPECT** players by using negative, hostile or intimidating language

#### ...towards SPECTATORS

Take ownership of your pivotal role in the **ENGAGEMENT**, **SAFETY**, **LEARNING** and creation of a **RESPECTUL** matchday environment

Avoid ENGAGING in confrontations or disputes with other spectatorsalways maintain a calm and **RESPECTFUL** demeanour as a role model for positive behaviours

#### ...towards REFEREES

Be **RESPECTFUL** by using appropriate language

Role model the positive and **RESPECTFUL** behaviours we want the players to replicate

Do not **DISRESPECT** referees by using negative, hostile or intimidating language

Do not question the integrity of the match officials

Do not create an **UNSAFE** environment for referees by allowing poor behaviours from yourself or your own team members to go unchecked

# **DRYFC Matchday rules**

#### **Coaches, Team Managers and Club Officials**

#### On and off the field, I will:

- › Always show respect to everyone involved in the game
- > Stick to the rules and celebrate the spirit of the game
- > Encourage fair play and high standards of behaviour
- Always respect the Referee and encourage players to do the same
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive behaviour
- Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on others
- Be gracious in victory and defeat
- Respect the facilities home and away

# I understand that if I do not follow the rules, I may be:

- Required to meet with the club or league Welfare officer or your CFA Designated Safeguarding Officer (DSO).
- Suspended by the club from attending matches
- Suspended or fined by the County FA
- Required to leave, lose my position and/or have my license withdrawn

#### **Spectators and Parents/Carers**

- > Have fun; it's what we're all here for!
- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides
- Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same
- Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

# I understand that if I do not follow the rules, I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- › Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependent/s and/or issued a fine
