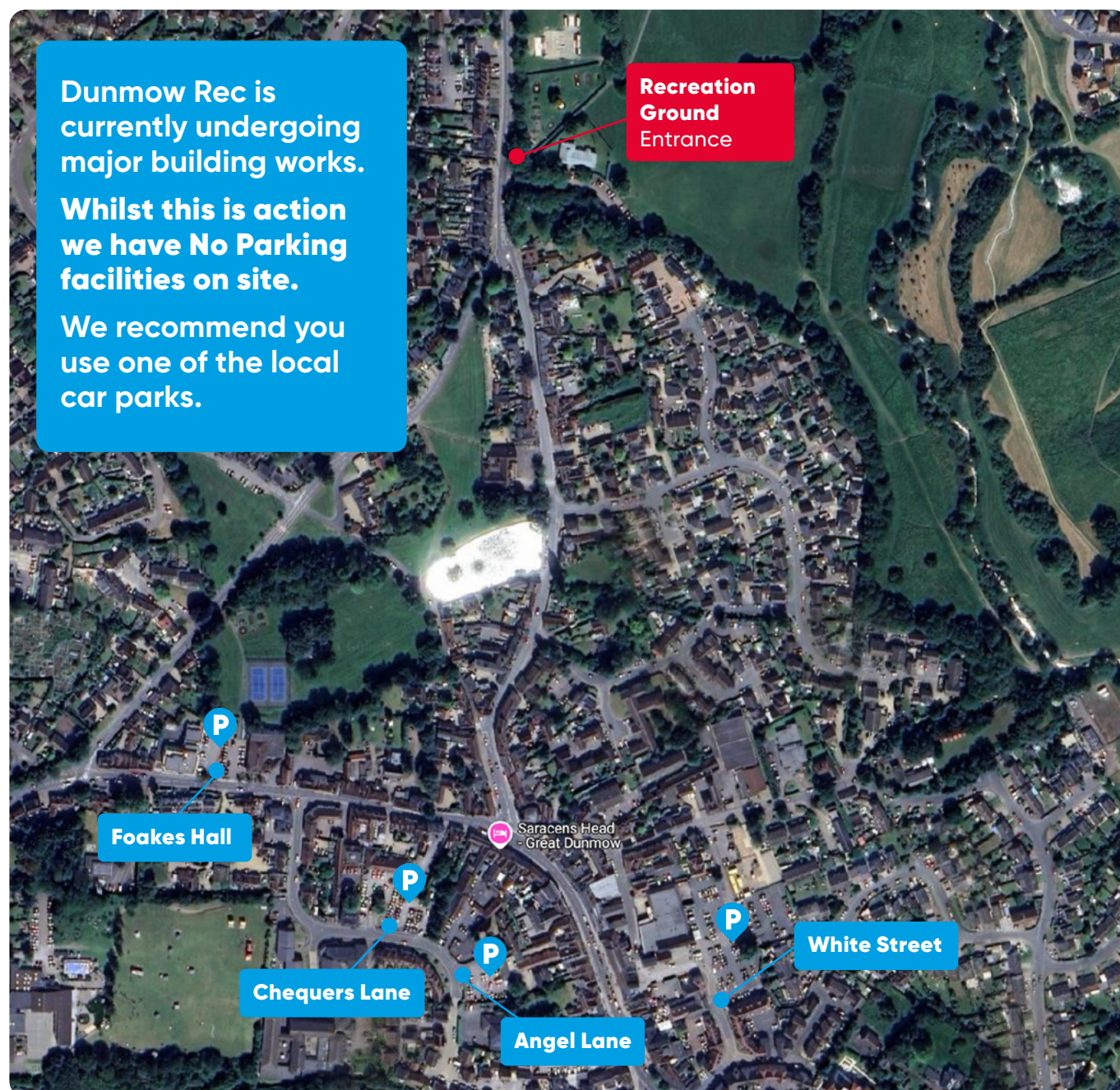

THE DO'S AND DONT'S OF MATCHDAY BEHAVIOUR FOR SPECTATORS



...towards COACHES



RESPECT the coach and the decisions made by supporting the players through the tasks they have been given

Do not **DISRESPECT** the coach and negatively impact the **LEARNING** of players through confusing and contradictory instruction

...towards CLUBS

Remember that the players, coaches and referee may be **LEARNING** the game

Encourage your child and/or players to **RESPECT** the opposition and match officials

RESPECT the opposition, and the badge and values of your own club

Do not affect the **SAFETY** of others by entering the field of play without reasonable permission

...towards PLAYERS

Remember that most players **ENGAGE** in football because it's fun

RESPECT and appreciate good play, whichever team it comes from

Do not **DISRESPECT** players by using negative, hostile or intimidating language

...towards SPECTATORS

Take ownership of your pivotal role in the **ENGAGEMENT, SAFETY, LEARNING** and creation of a **RESPECTFUL** matchday environment

Avoid **ENGAGING** in confrontations or disputes with other spectators - always maintain a calm and **RESPECTFUL** demeanour as a role model for positive behaviours

...towards REFEREES

Be **RESPECTFUL** by using appropriate language

Role model the positive and **RESPECTFUL** behaviours we want the players to replicate

Do not **DISRESPECT** referees by using negative, hostile or intimidating language

Do not question the integrity of the match officials

Do not create an **UNSAFE** environment for referees by allowing poor behaviours from yourself or your own team members to go unchecked

Be part of the reason why people love the game, not leave the game.
Be a positive role model.

DRYFC Matchday rules

Coaches, Team Managers and Club Officials

On and off the field, I will:

- › Always show respect to everyone involved in the game
- › Stick to the rules and celebrate the spirit of the game
- › Encourage fair play and high standards of behaviour
- › Always respect the Referee and encourage players to do the same
- › Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- › Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive behaviour
- › Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on others
- › Be gracious in victory and defeat
- › Respect the facilities home and away

I understand that if I do not follow the rules, I may be:

- › Required to meet with the club or league Welfare officer or your CFA Designated Safeguarding Officer (DSO).
- › Suspended by the club from attending matches
- › Suspended or fined by the County FA
- › Required to leave, lose my position and/or have my license withdrawn

Spectators and Parents/Carers

- › Have fun; it's what we're all here for!
- › Celebrate effort and good play from both sides
- › Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same
- › Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- › When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time
- › Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

I understand that if I do not follow the rules, I may be:

- › Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- › Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- › Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- › Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- › Required to leave the club along with any dependent/s and/or issued a fine
